



Draw to the Button Rules

Friday, April 10, 2009 Elimination Round – Curling Beauséjour

Informal Rules:

- Order of participant's throws will be determined by each participant drawing a number; number one (1) will go first, number two (2) will go second, etc.
- Each Participant will have one (1) practice throw and then one (1) competition throw
- Participant must announce before their first throw **if they are declining** their practice throw
- Each Participant's throw will be measured and recorded by the Official
- The six (6) competitors with the closest throws will continue on to the Semi Final Round

Saturday, April 11, 2009 - Semi-Final Round Moncton Coliseum During 5th end break of playoff games

- Order of competitors throws for the Semi-final round will be determined from the measurements from the Elimination round held Friday, April 10th, 2009 at Curling Beauséjour
- There will be **no practice throw** at the semi-final round
- Each participant will be allowed only one (1) attempt
- Each participant's throw will be measured and recorded by the official
- The three (3) competitors with the closest throws will continue on to the Final Round

Sunday, April 12, 2009 – Final Round Moncton Coliseum During 5th end break of medal games

- Order of competitors throws for the Final Round will be determined from the measurements from the Semi-Final round held Saturday, April 11, 2009 at the Moncton Coliseum
- There will be **no practice throw** at the final round
- Each participant will be allowed only one (1) attempt
- Each Participant's throw will be measured and recorded by the Official
