Honourary Chairs—Olympic Gold 10th Anniversary

The 2008 Scotties Tournament of Hearts Host Committee is thrilled to have the greatest team in women's curling as the Honourary Chairs of the 2008 Canadian Women's Curling Championship. Jan Betker, Joan McCusker, Marcia Gudereit, Atina Johnston (Ford) and Anita Ford have agreed to be ambassadors and promoters for our event.

The Schmirler Team won three Canadian Women's Curling Championships and three World titles in 1993, 1994 and 1997. Later in 1997, this awesome team won the Canadian Olympic Curling Trials in dramatic style – a historic shot made by Sandra won the day. This team from Saskatchewan became Team Canada and was on the road to Nagano and the Olympic Games.

Sandra, Jan, Joan, Marcia, Atina and Anita trained hard and reorganized their complicated lives that included jobs, husbands and children. They were over whelmed at times; however the dream of gold remained in their hearts. The team with the most dedicated and supportive husbands made the long trip to Japan. Once on the ice the Team Schmirler – Team Canada skillfully swept the competition away and on February 15, 1998 they won Olympic Gold. This was the first gold medal in curling for Canada and is still the only gold medal for Canadian women's curling. All of Canada readily identified with Team Schmirler – a happy group of friend and mothers from the prairie heartland. We are all still so proud of the team and their unmatched

accomplishments.

The 2008 Scotties Opening Gala Dinner on Friday, February 15, 2008, 10 years to the day of the historic Olympic Gold Medal win, will honour this team and all its accomplishments. They will be acknowledged as the Queens of curling. It will be an emotional evening of cherished memories.

The Schmirler Team will also be honoured at the Opening Ceremonies on Saturday, February 16, so please be there to cheer them on. We have another event in the planning stages. It will be staged on the Frederick W. Hill Mall at noon on Friday, February 15, 2008. Stay tuned for more details and let's pack the Mall to honour the team and kick off the Scotties with a bang.

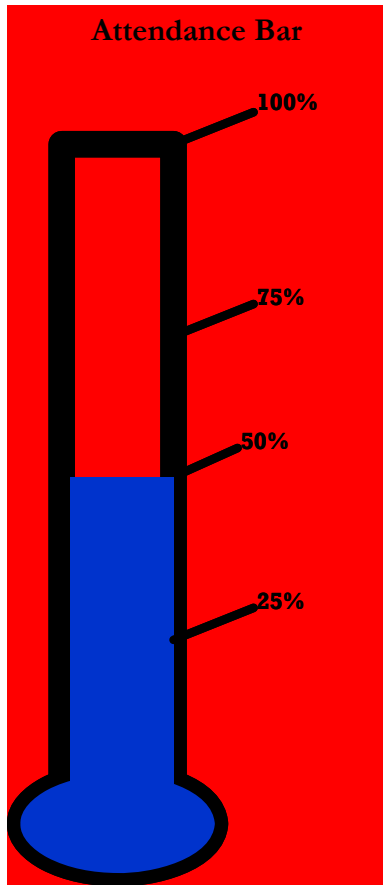
Women curlers from coast to coast dream of being involved in the Scotties Tournament of Hearts as it is acknowledged as the leading sporting event

While 'green is the colour' for residents of the City of Regina and our province, the excitement is also mounting for Hearti Gras, the 2008 Scotties Tournament of Hearts, now only a few short months away.

There has been a lot of enthusiasm raised over the Scotties in the past few months as we head into the homestretch leading up to February 16 - 24, 2008.

Our volunteer committees continue their diligent work on plans to make Hearti Gras an unqualified success. We thank all volunteers who have signed up for this event and we thank you for all your contributions to date, it is very much appreciated.

On the ticket front, we recently announced an exciting Family Ticket Package, hoping to take advantage of the February long weekend in 2008, the same weekend Hearti Gras kicks off. A media event was held in late October announcing the Family Ticket Packages as well as two weekday packages, The Early Riser and The Night Owl. Mayor Pat Fiacco attended the media event where he proclaimed February 16 - 18, 2008 as 'Family Day weekend at the Scotties in Regina.' Family Size packages include six individual draw tickets for just \$60 to any of the eight draws over the three days or ten tickets for just \$75. The Early Riser includes the six morning and afternoon draws February 18 - 20 for \$80 and The Night Owl includes three evening draws from February 18 - 20 for just \$40. Ticket sales are steady. There is very good inventory left within all the packages, so again encourage all those you know

to purchase a ticket to see the top notch curling in the Brandt Centre. Watch for further individual ticket announcement shortly as well as an upcoming special Christmas promotion.

The Scotties also had the opportunity of hosting the defending World Women's Champion Kelly Scott in September. Kelly and her teammates, despite being from B.C., took time to sign autographs for many Rider fans at the September 22 Rider home game against the B.C Lions. The exposure from this event was fantastic.

accreditation process was used, with information taken from the volunteer database and confirmed by the volunteers as they arrived. This allowed the accreditation process to flow more smoothly, and reduced duplication of entering data by volunteers.

We continue to develop plans for the on-ice ceremonies, the Scotties

banquets and special events, the Heartfest events and displays, information booths, and decorations.

We are now staffed with 637 volunteers and are taking names for a waiting list.
