Ice Tech Team

The Ice Tech Team will be led by **Craig Bancroft**, Head Ice Tech at BGCC. Supporting Craig will be **Dave Stavetieg**, **Mike Dales** and **Kevin Scott**. These gentlemen have worked on Ice Teams for '06 Tournament of Hearts, '07 Brier, '07 and '08 Ontario Men's Championship, the last seven United States Men's, Women's and Junior Championships, '09 US Olympic Qualifiers and the '08 Worlds.

Rocks

- The club has original rocks purchased new in 1957, Blue-Hone granite.
- Rocks were re-conditioned during the summer of 2008 by Canada Curling Stone, including striking bands and running surfaces.
- Less than 4 oz. was removed from each rock, all remaining well within the CCA required weight range should future work be required. This is not anticipated in near future.
- Rocks will be equipped with CCA electronic handles with [Eye-On-The-Hog](#) technology.
- Rocks behaved beautifully last season with up to four to four and half feet of curl.

New Clubhouse Opens July 2008 Clubhouse of the Year Award
